TNA meets US State Department officials



Tamil National Alliance (TNA) representatives to engage in discussions with the US State Department officials regarding the proposed new Sri Lankan Constitution. TNA has stressed the need for a new Constitution to resolve the Tamil national ethnic question when they met representatives of the European Union (EU) in September 2021. TNA Leader R. Sampanthan in October had stressed on the need for immediately compiling a new Constitution to help resolve issues pertaining to the minority Tamil community.

TNA MP M.A. Sumanthiran urged that Sri Lanka needs to "go beyond" the controversial 13th Amendment to the Constitution to achieve "meaningful devolution." The 13th Amendment to the Constitution, passed in 1987 and supported by the Government of

India, created the provincial councils electoral system which led to the establishment of provincial councils in each province in the country in an attempt at the devolution of power. However, some members of the ruling Sri Lanka Podujana Peramuna (SLPP) recently called for its Repeal. "There can be no 'middle ground'. It is the Rajapaksa Government that gave repeated assurances about 'implementing the 13th Amendment to the Constitution in full and also going beyond it so as to achieve meaningful devolution' after the end of the war. So, it is not 'middle ground' that must be found; it should be 'going beyond' the 13th Amendment to the Constitution," said Sumanthiran at the time. Since 2017, provincial councils elections have not been held as the then Government attempted to introduce legislative changes to the Provincial Councils Act to reform the electoral process. The new system envisioned a hybrid-style system of both first-past-the-post and proportional representation as opposed to the current system of proportional representation. When Indian Foreign Secretary Harsh Vardhan Shringla visited Sri Lanka last month, he had reportedly urged on the need to hold the Provincial Councils Elections as well. Foreign Minister Prof. G.L. Peiris said last month that the work on the new Constitution has been finalised by the committee led by Romesh De Silva PC and that it will be presented in Parliament in January 2022.

ONE COUNTRY ONE LAW

-Consolidating and entrenching Buddhism-

President Gotabaya's latest Presidential Task Force headed by a convicted, jailed and pardoned Gnanasara Thero who is the founder of Bodu Bala Sena (Peoples' Power Force) is entrusted to "Make a study of the implementation of the concept of "One Country One Law" within Sri Lanka and prepare a draft Act for the said purpose, to study the drafted Acts and amendments that have already been prepared by the Ministry of Justice in relation to this subject and their appropriateness and if there are suitable amendments to submit proposals for this purpose and include them in such relevant draft as is deemed appropriate, aiming to secure the highest proposal for Sri Lanka". The implications and fallout from this Task Force spell disastrous consequences for the entire population of Sri Lanka. During a video conference on September 30, 2021, he said "THERE IS NO MINORITY RACE IN THE COUNTRY. THE RACE SRI LANKANS ONLY EXISTS IN THIS COUNTRY."

It has to be pointed out that Sri Lankans cannot be categorized and described as a race and in Sri Lanka three races are in existence for thousands of years, they are the Sinhalese, Tamils and Muslims with each race possessing its own distinct traits and characteristics. Furthermore, Thero & #39;s statements indicate his aim. "TO SECURE THE HIGHEST PROTECTION FOR SRI LANKA.". But he has not detailed the dangers facing the country.

Furthermore, the proposed concept will tarnish the image of Sri Lanka internationally when it is grappling with punitive actions from UN and UNHRC Resolutions and Recommendations. Home sales in GTA reached 2nd-highest level on record for the month of October.



Home sales in the Greater Toronto Area (GTA) reached the second-highest level on record for the month of October. However, the inventory of homes for sale did not keep up with demand. The number of new listings was down by approximately one-third compared to October 2020. Market conditions tightened across all major home types compared to last year, and the annual rate of average price growth remained in the double digits, including for the resurgent condominium apartment segment.

"The only sustainable way to address housing affordability in the GTA is to deal with the persistent mismatch between demand and supply. Demand isn't going away. And that's why all three levels of government need to focus on supply. The federal government has stated that collaboration with provinces and municipalities is required. This collaboration could be spearheaded, at least in part, with housing-related incentives tied to federal infrastructure investment," said TRREB President Kevin Crigger.

GTA REALTORS® reported 9,783 sales through TRREB's MLS® System in October 2021 – down by 6.9 per cent compared to the October 2020 record of 10,503. A strong double-digit increase in condominium apartment sales mitigated annual declines in low-rise home sales. The number of new listings entered into the system was down by almost a third over the same period, with consistent declines across all major home types.

The MLS® Home Price Index Composite Benchmark was up by 24.2 per cent year-over-year. The average selling price for all homes combined rose by 19.3 per cent year-over-year to \$1,155,345. The low-rise market continued to drive price growth in October, but the annual price growth for condominium apartments was in the double digits as well.

"The tight market conditions across all market segments and areas of the GTA is testament to the broadening scope of economic recovery in the region and household confidence that this recovery will continue. A key part of future economic development in the GTA will be the ability to provide adequate ownership and rental housing supply so that people can continue to move to the region to live, work and spend money in the local economy," said TRREB Chief Market Analyst Jason Mercer.

Christmas

Christmas (which means "The Mass of Christ") is a Christian holiday that refers to the birth of Jesus (whom Christians believe is the Son of God), and a cultural holiday for non-Christians.

The day known as Christmas Day is celebrated on the 25th day of December. It is one of the most important days of the year for Christians, along with Easter when the death and resurrection of Jesus are celebrated. The season of preparing for Christmas is called Advent and begins on a Sunday about four weeks before Christmas. The Christmas Season (called Christmastide) ends 6 January or the Twelfth Day of Christmas, in which Epiphany is remembered.

Christmas is celebrated all over the world, as a religious holiday or as a time of celebration by Christians and non-Christians alike. The traditions are different from country to country, but they nearly always include a feast, giving gifts or cards, and enjoying church or public festivities such as singing Christmas carols and songs. Santa Claus is a tradition in many countries of the world.

Christmastide, as it is often called, is in the winter of the Northern Hemisphere, at a time when there were already ancient festivals. Some of the traditions that are used for Christmas are older than Christmas, or come from other non-Christian traditions such as Yule. Modern traditions of Christmas often focus on the giving of gifts. The season for retail stores to sell gifts, food, greeting cards, Christmas trees, and decorations begins the day about a month before Christmas Day.

Christmas celebrates the birth of Jesus. The story of how this happened is told in part of the Bible known as the Gospels. There are four Gospels telling the life of Jesus. The Gospel of Luke tells the most about his birth, and the Gospel of Matthew tells another part of the story. The Gospel of John says that Jesus came from God to bring his "Word" or message to all people.

The Gospels say that many years before Jesus' birth, prophets had told a promise to the Jewish people that God would send them a Messiah, or holy teacher. Christians believe that the promised Messiah was Jesus. His mother was a young woman called Mary, who was engaged, but not yet married to a carpenter called Joseph. Joseph found out that Mary was pregnant and was upset. He was wondering what he should do, when an angel came from God to tell him that the baby was the Holy One. The angel said that he must name the baby. This was a sign that he would take care of it like his own child.

At this time, the Middle East was ruled by the Romans. An order came that all the people had to travel back to their home town, to put their names on the taxation lists. Joseph took his new wife to Bethlehem. There was nowhere for them to stay, except a stable where the animals slept. This is where the baby was born. Joseph called him Jesus, as the angel had said.

The baby Jesus had two lots of visitors. On the night he was born, angels told some shepherds in the fields that they would find a newborn king lying in an animals' feed bin (or manger). Jesus' other visitors were some wise men who saw a new star in the sky and followed it, until they found the house where the family was now living and gave the young child expensive gifts of gold, incense and a precious herb called myrrh. (The wise men are often traditionally called the Three Kings, because there were three very expensive presents but the Bible does not say how many wise men there were.)

All these parts of the Christmas story are remembered and celebrated in different ways at Christmas: in pictures, songs, plays, stories and in models that are called "cribs", "creches" or "presepe".

Date of celebration

Most Christian countries of the world use a calendar called the Gregorian Calendar, but some churches use a calendar called the Julian Calendar. Most Christians, such as those of the Catholic and Protestant Churches, celebrate the birth of Jesus on 25 December, although holidays begin on 24 December also known as Christmas Eve.

The Eastern Orthodox Church still uses the Julian Calendar in some regions such as Russia. In such regions, Christmas is celebrated on 25 December in the Julian Calendar, but because of the difference between the calendars it is 7 January in the modern Gregorian Calendar.

Some Christians, like Jehovah's Witnesses, do not celebrate Christmas because there is no instruction from Jesus in the Bible which tells Christians to celebrate his birth. Mormons celebrate Christmas on 25 December but they believe that Christ's actual birth took place on 6 April.

BITTER JOURNEY

It was in Colombo Harbor...

We were waiting in a line as they let us in one by one.

'Nangoori', the name caught my eyes as I climbed the stairs of the ship which was waiting to be boarded. The name was written on the side of the ship in huge block letters in both Hindi and English.

The ship had set sail from India to give aid and safe passage to the affected Thamizh refugees of 1983 July racial conflict. After a long time, friendly faces welcomed us aboard the ship.

Following a long period of conflict and despair, the warm smile and caring gestures of our host felt comforting. More importantly we were relieved and felt safe. The thought of being a refugee in our own country made me sad. I turned around to check up on my sister. 'All I want is to get back home safely'. It was written all over her face.

The racial riots had been intensified during the past week, and my sister was very concerned and had thought that we would be lucky to get out of this alive. In the lower deck of the ship there were several beds. I made one for her and asked her to get some rest. All those sleepless nights made her fell asleep as soon as she closed her eyes.

At that time, I was in my teenage. Once my sister went to bed, me and my friends made our way to the upper deck. It was filled with familiar and unfamiliar faces sitting all over the place.

Everyone was scarred with disappointment as they were deceived by those who were supposed to stand by them in the first place.

We realized that we can no longer live together with them peacefully and even if we do, they wouldn't let us.

They have lost their loved ones, their livelihoods, their belongings, their dignity and so much more to this conflict. Although they have lost so much, at least for now they were all relieved to go back to their own land.

Suddenly I heard a woman crying. I turned around and saw a man standing beside her frozen like he had no way to comfort her.

I thought maybe it was her husband. If he was, then he would have hugged her to give her comfort. But in contrast he just stood there with helpless feeling. She was wailing in agony like a madwoman.

I felt like something was not right and was confused. I hurried down to the lower decks to my sister and whispered to her what I had seen. My sister had been a teacher and she was always there to support women in crisis. As soon as she heard about it, she hastily got out of the bed and ran to the upper decks. I followed her.

Now they were both arguing. She was now shouting back at him. But he was in no mood to listen to her. He then got furious, shoved her away and ran towards the edge of the ship. As he ran past us, my sister stepped in to stop him in case he tried something. Foolish.

'What happened?'

'Please just let me be'

'What are you so worked up about? Was she mean to you?'

'Never mind, just let me go'

'Why? If I let you go, what are you going to do?'

'I am so ashamed. I am going to commit suicide. I can't live anymore' he shook himself to get free of the grip.

What? Suicide? I was shaken for a moment. Could she have told something so hurtful to him when they were arguing? Could it be the reason for his decision to take his own life? All kinds of thoughts were running through my head. 'Okay, I will let you be.

But first tell me what happened. After that you can do as you wish,' said my sister. I don't know what he thought, but all of a sudden, he became silent. All I could hear was the sound of his inability. Suicide is a decision taken impulsively. If given proper thought into it, people are most likely to change that decision.

Now the woman walked towards my sister with hesitation. 'And you are...?' asked my sister.

'I am his wife' she replied after a brief pause.

'No! No! No!' he shouted with resentment. 'Isn't she your wife then?' my sister asked.

'No, I don't want her to be my wife anymore. I am so ashamed of the fact!' he spat at her with hatred. She wasn't expecting this. She was taken aback. 'I did what I did to save your life. Now you are blaming me?' she wailed in sorrow as she pounded her head with her hands. As they started to argue blaming each other for whatever happened, my sister

became more concerned about the woman and feared that she might take the wrong decision as her husband did. She waited for them to pour out their sorrows to each other. That woman had scratch marks on her cheeks and neck.

The thought of suicide might have occurred to them after they had lost their honor which they hold above all else. Now I started to understand why they took such a Decision.

Unable to witness her wailing in sorrow, my sister helped her to have a seat and consoled her. My sister signaled me to have an eye on her and walked back to her husband to ask about what happened. He complained that during the riot, a group of thugs assaulted her, tore her clothes off and molested her in front of him.

'You are a man, are you not? Why didn't you do something about it?'

'What more could I do?' 'You should have tried something to save her,' said my sister. 'How can I? I was overwhelmed and they had hatchets, guns and chains with them' 'At least both of you should have tried and run away'

'It was during the curfew. Military personnel were stationed at the junction. If we had run that way, they would have shot just. So....'

'So what?'

'So, we took hold of our little boy and decided to run out the back door to hide from them and that is when they caught us. They tied me down and those savages did this to her right in front of me...' he cried not knowing what to say.

My sister had no intent to hear out the rest of it. She could see the pain and sorrow in his eyes. The thought of him being unable to save his wife from such a horrible fate made him anxious. 'I did all I could. I yelled for help, I fought them as much as I can. They hit me in the head with the gun. I fell unconscious. I don't know what happened afterwards!' 'How did you all escape?'

'When I came back to my senses, I saw her, my wife crying alone in a corner with scratch marks all over her.

There was blood everywhere in her dress. In the morning they lifted the curfew for an hour. We escaped then and got to safety in a refugee camp' My sister didn't say anything. No one is to blame but those savages. My sister grabbed their boy and helped her down to the lower decks while trying her best to console her.

That bitter journey filled with sorrow, despair and pain continued for two days. When we made landfall at one of the ancestral places in the history of Tamil people, Kankesanthurai, she also came down with us.

Listening to my sister's advice had made them to change their decision to commit suicide. At that time my sister's daughter Rosa was volunteering in the temporary refugee camp. We told everything about them to her and handed them over to her to be looked after.

Every passenger of that ship was severely affected by the racial riots one way or the other. Maybe it was hearing all those sad stories from the refugees, it made Rosa troubled at heart for some time. Every refugee's sorrow seemed to be deeply rooted at her heart. She might be raging on the inside with anger and hate, by the fact that we, the rightful citizens of this very own country were made refugees in our own land.

A few days later Rosa told us that she was going to be a freedom fighter. She then enlisted into their ranks. Those troubled times never gave the people the luxury of thinking whether the path they had chosen for themselves was right or wrong. All the Tamil people who were affected by the racial riots had only one goal in their mind. That was to protect ourselves from such incidents in the future. Decades of being oppressed by the government made them to rise up in the form of armed conflict.

The enemy never understood the meaning of peaceful protests for rights. Every attempt of a peaceful protest against the oppression was in vain.

When my sister received the news of Rosa's death in a battle for Tamil people's rights, she didn't even flinch. She felt pride that her daughter had met a brave death in the battle for freedom rather than losing her honor to the enemy. The woman who my sister saved from committing suicide is now looking after an elder's home in Vanni. Her husband is in a mental institution.

His mind has turned on him, blaming and punishing himself for what happened. Her little boy has now committed himself in the fight against sand smuggling in Mullaitivu riverbeds. No one else can begin to understand the pain and sorrow they have gone through.

Not only during the racial riots, but also by the actions of some deranged politicians and their agendas, several Tamil families were shattered to their core. Some people want nothing of it and only wants to live in peace. But those in power are not letting them be. By the action of heartless weapon manufacturers and traffickers seeking profits in an unstable political situation, the armed conflict still ensues as the death toll piles up on both sides. It does not seem to end any time soon. No one knows what is right and what is wrong.


