Ontario reports lowest positivity rate since March

Ontario

Ontario health officials logged 1,135 new coronavirus cases, on May 27, 2021, but continuing a downward trend in new infections recorded over the past few weeks. The seven-day rolling average is now 1,441, compared to 2,131 seven days ago.

Ontario reported more than 1,100 new COVID-19 cases and 19 additional deaths on May 27, as the positivity rate marked a new low not seen since March. Ontario labs processed more than 37,700 a day prior to May 27, up from 24,008 tests the previous day. May 27 positivity rate is the lowest recorded since March 20 when the rate was also 3.6 per cent. Another 2,302 people recovered from the disease in the past 24-hour period, resulting in 16,541 active cases across the province.

In the Greater Toronto Area, Toronto logged 316 COVID-19 cases on May 27, up from 257 a day ago, while 271 new infections were reported in Peel Region, 75 in York Region, 25 in Durham Region and 46 in Halton Region.

Virus-related hospitalizations remained relatively unchanged day-over-day with 1,072 patients receiving treatment in Ontario hospitals. The number of patients in intensive care dropped by 22 from May 26 with 650 patients in ICUs. Of those in ICUs, 452 were breathing with the assistance of a ventilator.

Until May 27 th, the province has reported over 527,180 lab-confirmed coronavirus cases and 501,942 recoveries since the first infection was identified in January 2020.

& Trends are continuing in the right direction, and our situation in Ontario is improving, Ontario Chief Medical Officer of Health Dr. David Williams said on May 27. & If we keep going in this good direction, we will soon be able to look at entering in our framework and moving ahead on that.

The province has said that it expects to enter Stage 1 of its reopening plan, which would allow outdoor dining to resume and some non-essential retail to reopen, on June 14. The Ford government has indicated that the province can move to this stage until at least two weeks after 60 per cent of Ontarians have received their first dose of a COVID-19 vaccine.

As of May 26 evening, more than 8.5 million doses of COVID-19 vaccine have been administered across the province since mid-December.

Over 594,800 people have been fully vaccinated in Ontario.

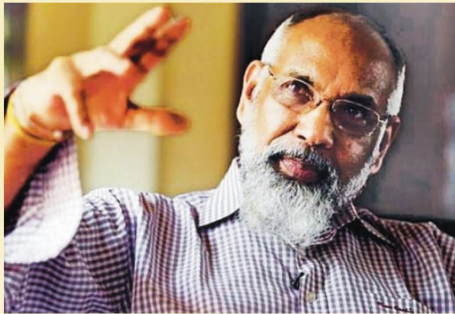

US together with Great Britain must ensure Justice & Accountability for the crimes perpetrated in Mullivaikal in May 2009.

It was a sad day in the year 2009 that we remember today (May 18). As far as we Sri Lankan Tamils of the North and East are concerned we have to face many obstacles even today. On one hand Covid 19 is playing havoc among us. On the other hand we face repression by the State in many ways. Personally, I would be called upon in a day or two to answer criminal charges for saying:

1. that the Tamil language was the language of the earliest inhabitants of this Island
2. that Mahawamsa is not a historical document
3. that the LTTE took up to arms because of repression and discrimination by the Sri Lankan State
4. that over a lakh of people were killed in Mullivaikal at the close of the War and
5. that the Armed Forces have taken over Civil functions and the North is kept under Army Rule, all of which are true but have been made out to be criminal. I am told by these statements I have propagated national and racial hatred that constitutes incitement to violence!

Thus repressive and reprehensible activities we face here in the North and East continuously.

It is amidst them that we remember our dead who passed away at Mullivaikal in May 2009. The British and the Tamils were tricked by the Sinhalese leaders at the time of Independence. Many promises were given prior to Independence that minorities would not be discriminated against and they would be treated with fraternal feelings.

But, within one year of Independence one million Tamils were deprived of their franchise.

We, Tamil speaking are the majority in the North and East of Sri Lanka. But our individuality is at stake. There are steps being taken inter alia to grab our traditional home lands to introduce Buddhism forcibly into areas where there are no indigenous Buddhists living, with Military help, to have our Resources plundered, to colonise settlements with Sinhala Colonists who have been brought from elsewhere into Tamil speaking areas and to have the demography of the area changed and to destroy war memorials.



It was to protect us from such genocidal acts on the part of the successive governments that our youth took up to arms. But due to the geo politics of Big Powers they were routed in 2009 together with over a lakh of innocents in Mullivaikal.

Justice to those, whose dear ones disappeared, eludes them even today. But those who committed, aided and abetted brutal criminal acts against our people are being given important Government positions and diplomatic postings. Today we witness the sorry spectacle of Memorials erected in remembrance of those who died at the end of the war, 12 years ago, being broken and destroyed.

The International Community is unable to do anything about it. A government in power seems to be able to attack and harm our people in Sri Lanka but the International Community can do nothing about it! In 2013 the then Conservative Prime Minister of Great Britain Hon' David Cameron visited us in Jaffna. At that stage he promised us that Justice and Accountability for what happened in Mullivaikal would be ensured. But anything tangible are still to be done. Even now the Conservatives are in power in Great Britain.

When Independence from Britain to Ceylon was given, the Sinhala Leaders of that time deceived the British by saying that they would look after the interests of the minorities for certain. But as soon as Independence was obtained over a million Tamils from the Upcountry were denied their citizenship. Thereafter there had been periodical discriminatory steps taken to undermine the safety and well being of the Tamil speaking in Sri Lanka.

Britain failed to ensure that there would be safety and fair play as far as the minorities in Ceylon were concerned. The mistake made at the time of Independence wherein adequate safeguards against the hegemony of the majority were not ensured by giving a federal constitution to Ceylon, still has its adverse effects on Sri Lanka even today.

But I would say that it is time now for the Conservative Government of Britain to ensure justice and fair play to our people. The mistake made during the term of office of Prime Minister Hon' Clement Atlee must now be corrected. I make this humble request on behalf of our people. It is certainly heartening to see that the Democratic Party which worked hard in the UN to bring Resolutions against the Sri Lankan Government is now back in power in the US.

US together with Great Britain must ensure Justice and Accountability for the crimes perpetrated in Mullivaikal in May 2009.

Thus taking Sri Lanka before the International Criminal Court stands a priority for the US and UK and other Countries who value democracy and fair play.

It is high time an International body of Experts on Military Law be asked to inquire into the need for the Military which committed severe human rights violations during the war, to continue to prolong their stay for the past 12 years.

The Government has publicly assured that the LTTE is no more. It has assured our Country that there are no semblance of any attempts at violence of any sort in the North and East up to now. If so why should the Armed Forces continue to be in the North and East.

It is not enough to say in a Democracy for security reasons without spelling out what those security reasons are. We find the Military holding on to over 60000 acres of State Land and over 3000 acres of private land. We find them getting involved directly or indirectly in cultivation, fishing, trading, expropriation of our resources and so on. We find them helping those who are interested in land grabbing in the North and East coming from elsewhere. We find them aiding and abetting those who are trying to distort history.

We find them trying to brainwash our people, especially the youngsters, by working on their poverty and indigent circumstances. Therefore security reasons cannot be the motive for the Military continuing to occupy our traditional homelands for twelve years after the war. We must be told the actual reasons and the reasons must be investigated by an International Panel of Military Law Experts.

I had suggested when I was Chief Minister that if lack of space was the reason notto house the Military in Colombo and its suburbs, the Government could divide its Military into nine parts and establish their one ninth Military in each of the nine Provinces. Why should the Government garrison such a large contingent of the Military in the North and East alone? Does the Government intend placing an occupational Army in the North and East for ever curtailing, controlling, commanding and covering our people by spying on them under the cover of intelligence gathering? Are we not entitled to a free, democratic and un-interfered existence in our traditional homelands? Surely the Police could now take over security since it is peace time now.

It is important in order to bring an end to the suffering of the Tamil speaking majority in the North and East of Sri Lanka that an internationally supervised Referendum be conducted in the North and East.

That is the most democratic step that the International Community could take to ensure peace and reconciliation in Sri Lanka. This attempt to usher in a Referendum among the majority Tamil speaking people in the North and East must be ensured by not only US and the UK but also Canada, India, Australia, the European Union and many other Countries which value Democracy and Democratic institutions.

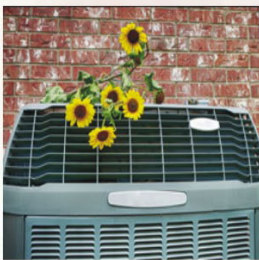

OUR HISTORIC VISIT TO BALI ISLAND AND MODERN TRENDS IN HINDUISM AMBI CHINNIAH

In 2011, I was fortunate to visit the island of Bali, in Indonesia, on the invitation of Dr. Ramesh Sastri, the Director of Mahendra Datta University.

Visiting Bali was something I had contemplated for more than twenty years. My friend, the late Mr. Sharma of the Indian High Commission, often referred to Bali as the land of a thousand Sivan temples. He had visited the island in 1989 and was impressed by the predominance of Hinduism and the way in which the ancient traditions of Hinduism survived since the beginning of the first century A.D.

Prior to the advent of Hinduism, ancient Bali was a nation steeped in animism and worshipping of spirits and demons. As Hinduism began to spread, the Balinese people struggled to retain the sacred traditions of Hinduism, and let go some of the more extreme ascetic aspects of Hindu worship.

Modern day Balinese Hinduism is an amalgamation of Indian religions and some aspects of Buddhism and indigenous animist customs of ancient Bali. Hinduism is officially referred as 'Agama Hindu Dharma' as well as Siva Buddha in Bali.

Hinduism in Bali grew as it adapted with the diverse cultural practices of the locals. Indian Hindus believe in vegetarianism, worship the cow 'Nandi' in Siva worship and the abhor the consumption of beef. But in Bali, Hindus do not adhere to vegetarianism and are avid beef eaters.

Despite these inconsistencies, the Hindus in Bali are noted for the devotion with which they faithfully practice their religion. Their dedicated daily ritual include offering & Comang Sari three times a day (morning, noon and evening) to the almighty creator Lord Siva.

The 'Comang Sari' consists of a small package woven in palm leaf and elegantly decked with fragrant flowers, select herbs and freshly cut fruits. These offerings are seen at the door ways of most houses and on sidewalks in front of shops and businesses. It is considered a sacrilege to even accidentally step on the offerings which are consecrated to God.

Being a devout Hindu, I was curious to see how the people of Bali followed the ancient traditions of Hinduism. Most Balinese could recite verses from the epics Mahabaratha, Ramayana and the Baghavat Gita. I wanted to understand how these sacred traditions of Hinduism came to be cherished and avidly retained in Balinese Hinduism.

The origins of Hindu traditions in Bali can be traced to the religious zeal of South Indian kings to spread Hinduism to the neighboring south east Asian countries from Burma, Sumatra, Malaysia, Cambodia, Java and Indonesia including Bali. The first century inscriptions unearthed in Western Indonesia confirm the widespread adoption of 'Siva Lingam' worship during that time.

The heavy concentration of Hindus in Bali was due to historical developments after the spread of Islam in mainland Indonesia. The religious intolerance led Hindus from all parts of Indonesia to retreat to the island of Bali. Hinduism became sheltered in Bali and continues to be the last bastion of Hinduism in present day Indonesia.

As devout Hindus the Balinese are simple, honest people who believe in Karma and the Karmic laws of retribution. We discovered the simple honesty of the people in Bali when we lost a wrist watch at a restaurant. We were stunned by the recovery of the expensive watch after a lapse of three days. We went hesitantly to the restaurant and were astonished that the receptionist had the wrist watch at hand and declined to accept any money for this act of generosity. For the Balinese, this was an honest simple routine act of service to Lord Siva their almighty God.

It has been estimated that there are no less than ten thousands Hindu temples in Bali. They range in size from small shrines in housing complexes to large astounding temples of great repute. They were built to precision by visiting South Indian Architects and Sculptors to emulate the magnificence of the ancient temples of India.

The small shrines are spread all over Bali and most are dedicated to ancestor worship by Balinese families. There are also some small shrines dedicated to various spirits to protect their families and their fields from evil force.

In Bali, there are more than twenty large historic Hindu temples, many of which were built in ancient times by several great kings. These temples were built to precision by highly skilled sculptors and architects from South India who were invited by the kings to build these temples for the glory of Hinduism. Though the temples in Bali bear some resemblance to Hindu temples in South India, they were missing the 'Gopuram' at the door way or entrance to the temple.

Instead of the Indian style 'Gopuram' the Balinese temples have been designed to accommodate the towering Hindu-Buddhist tiered Pagodas similar to the Pagodas built in China and Japan. Balinese Hindu temples are designed on a square Hindu temple plan as an open air worship place in the outer perimeter with enclosed walls that are connected with a series of intricately decorated Gates.

Most festivals are conducted in the outer courtyard of the temple. This is where most dramas are held after the temple ceremonies. The dramas depict the moral lessons instilled in the Vedas and epics like Ramayana and Mahabaratha. The inner sanctum of the temple is the sacred resting place for the almighty in the form of a deity. The transition zone between is for the storage of sacred items required for all ceremonies including the garb of the deities and the sarongs or garb for the priest and the worshippers at the temple.

The first temple I visited was the 'Tanah Lot' a popular Sivan Temple dedicated to Lord Siva in western Bali. The temple was built on a large rock encircled by sea water. The other Sivan temple we visited was the 'Uluwatu' temple dedicated to Lord Siva as Rudra. This is one of the biggest temples in Kuta district in Southern Bali. The temple is set on a sea cliff facing the Indian ocean.



Another temple dedicated to Lord Siva and his consort Parvathy is the Pura Ulun Danu Bratan' the major Shavaite water temple in Bali.

The Batukaru temple 'Pura Lahur' is one of Bali's important temples in the central highlands also devoted to Lord Siva as 'Maha Deva'. We regret not having made our homage to the 'Mother Temple, Pura Besakhi' on the slopes of an active volcano on Mount Agung.

Balinese believe that Lord Shiva and a pantheon of Gods chose this temple as their throne and most holy palace abode near the peaks of Mount Agung. This is similar to our Hindu belief in



'Kailash' as the throne and palace abode of Lord Siva and other Gods on the Mountain peaks of the Himalayas in Tibet.

These temples in Bali, reflect a belief in one supreme being in Lord Siva and that all other Gods worshipped are manifestations of Lord Siva the supreme being.

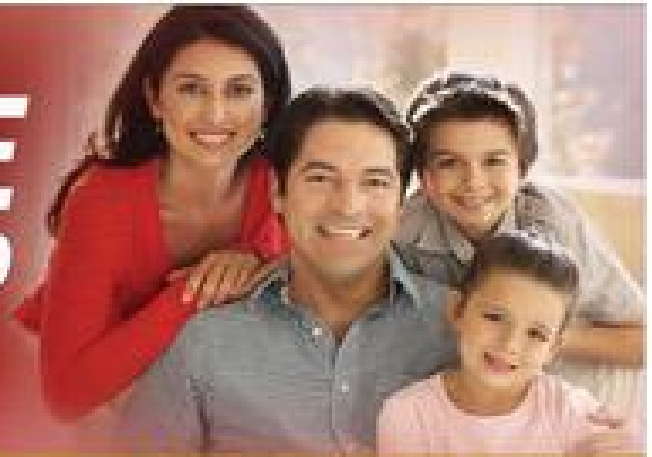

What to do with your kitchen scraps

(NC) Many of us are trying to live a more sustainable life. Reducing waste and reusing what we have are cornerstones of helping to create a healthier planet. At the same time, it's important to evaluate how we follow these principles to make sure they are not doing more harm than good.

Kitchen scraps are an important example of this. For many farmers, the best thing to do with food waste or leftovers is to feed it to their pigs. These animals eat outrageous amounts of just about anything, so it's an economical and seemingly environmentally friendly solution to prevent waste in your kitchen.

But overall, feeding any animal kitchen scraps is not the safest choice for their health. Not only can it lead to overfeeding and weight issues, but it could also potentially expose your animal to harmful diseases. For pigs, the risk of contracting African swine fever (ASF) is especially great.

ASF has not been found in Canada yet, but it's been present in countries across Africa, Asia and Europe. A virus that cannot be contracted by humans, it's highly contagious and deadly for pigs. It can survive for months in fresh, frozen, cooked or processed pork products. If contaminated food is fed to a pig it could start an outbreak, even from trace amounts of the virus.

Safer uses for food scraps include:

- Composting (as long as it's stored far from your pigs) there's always a need for nutrient dense soil
 - Making broth by simmering leftover bones and veggie scraps on the stove
 - Freezing them, if your garbage collection is rare or inconvenient or until you have enough to cook with
 - Getting creativeextra meat scraps from butchering can make sausages, chili or meatloaf to use up less desirable bits of meat
- To avoid harm to your pets or livestock, always practice good biosecurity and follow regulations in your area.
