First time, our committee has also decided to form the 'Hartleyites Sports Club (UK)' in order to engage young Hartleyites within our Association. Hartley vs Jaffna Hindu, Battle of Blues Cricket Match was held at the Old Tiffinians playing fields. It was organised and played very well. We have developed www.hcppauk.org website for our publications.

Our Hostel Donor, Mr Ian K. Karan (Senator, Hamburg), has graciously accepted our requirements for the hostel renovation works as well as the expense of purchasing an adjoining land of our sports ground. Government has donated a 26 seater coach for the school use and other exciting projects worth Rs 130 million. In addition, a Technical Faculty, two classroom buildings each three levels, and Principal quarters are in the pipeline to be built with the help of the Government funding. In fact, the principal quarters and one of the classroom building foundation stones are already laid out.

I would like to thank our Special guest Mr S Mylvaganam MBE and Mrs D Mylvaganam accepting our invitation and being with us today. 
