During this difficult time your continuous support to the school helped them to take part in the academic and sports activities. You also helped along with other branches to develop infrastructure of the school and grounds. Some years ago you built the school canteen and currently you are hoping to build the upper floor.

This year you set up a Digital library with 10 tabs to help the students to encourage reading, also continuing to pay the stipend of the English teacher. To encourage music and fine arts, they were presented with six miruthangams. Solar panels to the college were installed by Mr. Rathesan a member of your PPA.

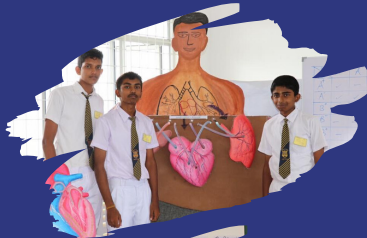
Also news to note that the Technical Lab it was sponsored by the government and now have been completed for the use of the students.

MESSAGE FROM THE TREASURER OF HCPPA (UK)



I am pleased to present the HCPPA(UK) accounts for the financial year ending 30th September 2019. The accounts, audited by Kugan & Company, are included with the Annual Report and are available to those who wish to have a copy.

Continuous successful past years have resulted in a good financial reserve. I am pleased to report that, through careful management of events, we have ended the year with the surplus of £10,772 (2018-£10,542).

Once again, I would like to thank each one of the members and well-wishers for our continued success. As at 30'th September 2019 the total amounts deposited in the fixed deposit funds in Srilanka amounts to £29,994. During 2018-2019 financial year we have transferred £10,000 to HCPPA Trust which in turn transferred £5,000 towards capital fund and £2,600 for revenue expenditure to HCPPA Global Trust.

We received £4,000 from Dr Tamilson and £2,000 from Mr George Arun specifically to be utilised for needy hostellers of which £2,000 was sent during the year to HCPPA Global Trust and also Mr Senthuran directly sent £1,000 to support another hostel student.

Detailed statement of affairs of our Trust is attached to the Financial Statements. We have been able to utilise the interest generated from these funds to support various school projects currently in operation such as supplement English teachers, sports and fine arts activities.

Our total income for the year on our activities viz, Annual Dinner, Gala Day/Sports, Natha Vinotham, Sports Club and Membership amounted to £31,293, of which £20,040 came from Natha Vinotham 19. Our total expenditure of these activities for the year was £19,743.

The detail Income and Expenditure of each activity is in the attached financial statements.

I urge each one of you to give your continuous support in order to continue these projects. In summary I am pleased to report yet again a successful year. I am sure that new committee will do better and wish them good luck
