1)LOCAL GOVERNMENT



a. An unoccupied building in Mandaitivu since 2015 was repurposed by the Rural Department to conduct a weekly market in the Mandaitivu area. This reopening was held on the 9th of April 2022 with the participation of HDOs and ministry staff.









b. As a result of 25 Million fund allocation by the PSDG for housing, 25 beneficiaries were chosen from women headed families, low income extended families and war effected persons with disability and non-curable diseases. Thus periodically the housing monitoring team visits these building sites to release part payments by the ministry. Such a monitoring took place on the 27th April 2022.







2) EDUCATION

a. The National Drama Day on 2nd April was celebrated by conducting a Drama Training Workshop by the Department of Cultural Affairs. Mr. C. Raghavendan, Assistant lecturer, graced this event and awarded participation certificates.







b. Vacant schools in the Northern Province will be given priority and appointment letters will be issued to the 355 National Teaching Diploma holders related to teaching who have been selected and sent by the Central Ministry of Education for appointment as teachers in the Northern Province schools. Letters of appointment were issued at the National College of Education, Jaffna on Friday 29th April 2022.





c. With the assistance of the Department of Cultural Affairs, celebration of the Cultural Festival 2022 jointly organized by the Jaffna Divisional Secretariat and Jaffna Cultural Association on the 29th of April 2022 at the Jaffna Divisional Secretariat conference hall.

The festival was exclusively adorned by the presence of the Chief Guest, District Secretary, Mr.K.Mahesan, the Special Guest Assistant Director, Department of Cultural Affairs, Mrs. Rajamalligai Sivasuntharasarma and Guest of Honour Mrs. Vasanthi Kunjithapadham, dancer at Yazh Rathna.

Several performances including the cultural procession of the students under the divison, launch of 'யாழ் பாடி 6 மலர்', awarding of artists, flute reciatation by Geethavakini music school and 'பூதத்தம்பி' folk dance by the entertainers beautified the occasion.
