b. Under direction of the Chief Priest Shivashri Naguleswara Kurukkal in association of other priests of the temple special prayers were conducted for the souls which passed away due to violence, to reach heaven. Then the Chief Priest together with other priests of the temple made offerings to the souls at the bank of Keerimalai. Furthermore, Department of Cultural Affairs offered gifts to the old devotees who stayed at the temple. The staff of Department of Cultural Affairs, Cultural officers of Tellipalai Divisional Secretariat, staff of Divisional secretariat also accompanied in the event.









a. A field visit was made to a selected land in Allaipiddy in order to establish a Resort/ Retirement wellness home. It was arranged on 14<sup>th</sup> of July 2022 to observe the nature of the land and surrounding for the preparation of the roadmap for the Retirement Homes.









b. Mobile service of District Siddha Hospital – Jaffna was started at Achchuvely Certified School on 18<sup>th</sup> of July 2022.As an initial stage of transferring District Siddha Hospital from Kurunagar – Jaffna to the school in Achchuvely the mobile service was started and continued every Fridays. Mobile clinic was conducted by the doctors and staff of District Siddha Hospital – Jaffna. At the end of July 128 patient visits were recorded.





 c. 14 Food vouchers worth Rs. 10,000.00 each were donated to the guardians of orphaned children by Leads organization – Jaffna. A total of 14 most vulnerable persons from Chavakachcheri and point Pedro judicial divisions received the benefits.

Leads Jaffna coordinator, probation officers, Probation officer in-charge and fit persons participated in the program that was held on 16<sup>th</sup> July 2022 at Probation Unit Chavakachcheri and 15<sup>th</sup> July at Probation Unit Point Pedro.





The program was arranged by the DPCCS-NP with the coordination of Leads organization to assist the defenseless orphaned children during the current difficult situation.

### 3) <u>WOMEN'S AFFAIRS</u>

a. By the initiation of the Hon. Governor, Northern Province with the guidance of the Chief Secretary, Northern Province and the support and recommendations by the Nutritionist from the Department of Health, dry food was distributed to malnourished pregnant and lactating mothers in the fishermen families in 22 MOH divisions altogether from Jaffna, Killinochchi, Mullaitivu and Mannar districts in the Northern Province on the 20, 21 and 22<sup>nd</sup> of July 2022.

In the first phase 924 dry food packs were given to malnourished pregnant and lactating (1-6 months) mothers for two weeks by the Ministry of Women's Affairs, Northern Province to improve the child health.

The inauguration programme was held at the MOH office, Nallur. This event was chaired by the Secretary, Ministry of Women's Affairs, Northern Province. The Chief Secretary, Northern Province was invited as the Chief guest and the Provincial Director, Department of Health, Northern Province and the Medical Officer, Nallur were invited as Special guests to this event. Further Assistant Secretary, Chief Accountant and staff of the Ministry of Women's Affairs, Northern Province participated in this event.

a. Event of handing over of Successfully completed classroom building complex among the selected 13 schools considering the urgent activities was held on 26th of July 2022 in Kilinochchi district under the direction of Hon. The opening ceremony of building complex of KN/ Iyakkachchi G.T.M.School was ceremonially held at 8.30 am that day. The welcome speech was addressed by the school principal and the welcome event was held with the musical band after that the Chief guests hoisted the flags and Chief Secretary –NP and the UNICEF representatives unveiled the plaque and ribbon cutting ceremony of newly built classrooms was held respectively. Finally, the event came to an end with the speeches addressed by the guests and the vote of thanks.
