DRAFT ORDINANCES.

MINUTE,

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

Draft of an Ordinance for imposing Succession and Legacy Duties and increasing the Duties on certain Deeds of Gift or Settlement.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to impose succession and legacy duties, and to increase the duties on certain classes of deeds of gift or settlement: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Executor or administrator required to execute conveyances of immovable property.

- 1. In every case in which after the coming into operation of this Ordinance an order absolute is passed by a district court declaring any person entitled to have issued to him probate of a deceased person's will, or grant of administration of a deceased person's estate, it shall be the duty of such person in whose favour as executor or administrator such order is made, after payment of the funeral expenses, debts, and legacies of the deceased, to convey and transfer over to the person or persons entitled by inheritance, devise, or otherwise the immovable property situated in Ceylon belonging to or included in the estate of the deceased.
- 2. Every transfer or conveyance executed by an executor or administrator in pursuance of the provisions of the last preceding section shall be liable, in addition to the stamp duty imposed by "The Stamp Ordinance, 1890," to a further stamp duty of 5 per cent. on the value of the property so transferred and conveyed.
- to stamp duty of 5 per cent. on the value of the property conveyed, in addition to the duty chargeable under Stamp Ordinance, 1890.

Conveyances subject

- Receipts for legacy, money, or movable property.
- 3. (1) Before paying over any legacy or money, or handing over any movable property to any person or persons entitled thereto by inheritance, bequest, or otherwise, every executor and administrator shall require from the person or persons entitled a written receipt for the same.

Receipts subject to stamp duty of 5 per cent. on the value of the property received.

Duty imposed by this Ordinance to be a first charge.

In case of payment of legacy or other money, executor or administrator to deduct amount of duty.

In case of immovable or movable property, executor or administrator may apply to court to secure payment of duty by sale.

Proceeds of sale how appropriated.

Valuation of property subject to duty to be verified on oath by executor or administrator.

Penalty for neglect of duty by executor or administrator.

Additional duty on certain class of deeds of gift or settlement.

Provisions of Stamp Ordinance, 1890, to apply.

Commencement.

Short title

(2) Every such receipt shall be liable to a stamp duty of 5 per cent. on the amount of money payable to such person or persons, or the value of the property to be handed over to such person or persons.

4. (1) The duty imposed by section 2 shall be a first charge on the immovable property to be conveyed or transferred to the person or persons entitled thereto by inheritance, devise, or otherwise, and the duty imposed by section 3 shall be a first charge on the money or movable property to be paid or handed over to the person or persons entitled thereto by inheritance, bequest, or otherwise, and shall be payable by the person or persons entitled to such money or movable or immovable property.

(2) Before paying any legacy or money to any person or persons entitled thereto by inheritance, bequest, or otherwise, it shall be the duty of the executor or administrator to deduct the amount of duty payable thereon, and to affix to the receipt executed in terms of section 3 a stamp equivalent in value to the amount so deducted.

- (3) In the event of any person not placing the executor or administrator in funds for the purpose of enabling him to procure the necessary stamps for the payment of the duty imposed by this Ordinance, the executor or administrator, before conveying or transferring any immovable property, or handing over any movable property, shall apply to the district court which issued the probate or letters of administration for an order authorising the executor or administrator, as the case may be, to sell so much of the immovable or movable property to which such person is entitled as will suffice to pay the amount of duty chargeable thereon, and the court, after hearing all the parties interested, shall make order accordingly.
- (4) The executor or administrator shall apply the proceeds realised by such sale in the payment of the duty leviable under this Ordinance, and the balance (if any) shall be paid to the person entitled to the property so sold.
- 5. Every executor or administrator shall, after the time appointed for the commencement of this Ordinance, when filing his account under the provisions of section 553 of "The Civil Procedure Code, 1889," file therewith a full and true valuation, verified on oath or affirmation, of all the immovable and movable property in respect of which duty is payable under this Ordinance, together with the receipts required by section 3 of this Ordinance, and copies of all transfers and conveyances executed in pursuance of this Ordinance, showing the amount of duty paid in respect of each such transfer and conveyance.
- 6. Every executor or administrator who neglects to fulfil any obligation imposed on him by this Ordinance shall be liable to pay to Her Majesty double the amount of the duty which is chargeable on any immovable or movable property and money under this Ordinance, but which through such neglect is wholly or in part not paid, and such amount shall be a debt due from him to the Crown, and shall be recoverable by any of the ways or means now in force for the recovery of a debt due to the Crown.
- 7. In addition to the duty imposed by "The Stamp Ordinance, 1890," every gift or deed of gift of any property reserving to the grantor any life-interest or estate in the property, and every settlement or deed of settlement whereby the settler reserves to himself a life-interest in the property settled, shall be liable to a further stamp duty of 5 per cent. on the value of such property.
- 8. The provisions of "The Stamp Ordinance, 1890," shall, so far as the same are consistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, be deemed to be applicable to the stamp duties hereby imposed.
- 9. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the day of , and may be cited for all purposes as "The Succession and Legacy Duty Ordinance, 1891."
