In the Vivekachuda-
mani, there is a Sloka
which runs as follows:
'Durlabham Trayamevai-
tat Daivanugra-hetukam;
Manushyatvam Mumuk-
shutvam Mahapurusha-
samsrayah.' Three things
are very difficult to ob-
tain. Only through the
grace of God the Jivas
obtain them. To be born
as a human being is no
small privilege. It is a
very precious gift given
by God to the Jiva.
Having got a human
birth, to have an aspira-
tion for liberation is the
next difficult thing to
obtain. So, if one obtains
both these, one is indeed
doubly blessed. But hav-
ing been born as a human
being, if you do not want
to know, and yet even
after knowing that, if you
do not know the way,
you are not fully blessed.
Therefore, if you get the
shelter of a Mahapurusha,
one who has known what
has to be attained, and
one who is in a position
to show you the way,
you can admit that you
are thrice blessed. This
unique blessing has to be
remembered always. Then
alone will you be careful
not to waste the opportu-
nity. When you know the
real value of a thing, you
take proper care of it,
and not otherwise.

The only thing that
stands in the way of your
spiritual realisation is
your own mind, the ego,
or call it by any name
you like. It is precisely
in order to see that this
obstacle is removed and
one gets at the ultimate
goal of human life that
one goes to the preceptor
or Guru. The Guru has
destroyed the limiting
mind and he knows the
method as to how one
has to destroy it. Let us
suppose that a man who
is desirous of leading a
spiritual life goes to a
Guru and asks for his
advice and guidance; and
the Guru tells him, "Be
good, lead a virtuous life,
serve self only, love all,
share with others what
you have, purify the

mind, meditate with one-
pointed mind, etc." But,
if the man does not sin-
cerely strive to follow the
Guru's advice, what bene-
fit will he thereby derive?
Absolutely nothing. He
will be in no way better
than what he was. It
seems that one does not
want to practise any-
thing, but there is only
the expectation of the
result. What a sad state
of affairs!

This life on earth is a
halting on the way to the
achievement of the Goal
of life. Earthly life is
transitory, for it is seen
that everything that is
born dies. Death is not
the end of life, since with-
out a continuation of life
therefrom the value of
the deeds and experiences
in this life would be ren-
dered nugatory. There
were births and deaths
in the past, there will be
births and deaths in the
future too, until Self-
realization is attained.
Life is a long chain of
which the recurring
births, planetary lives and
deaths are links.

Birth is caused by de-
sires and actions, and
birth becomes the cause
of further desires and
actions. This present
life is therefore, meant
to train the individual to
qualify himself for a
higher life, viz, to stop
births and deaths ulti-
mately. This life is not
the goal or the end, even
as the path is not the
same as the destination.
If earthly life were the
final goal, none would

no sense of imperfection
and no further urge or
aspiration to transcend
the present condition.

An Analysis of the TIRUMANTIRAM

(By A Science Graduate)

622 If you rest (in meditation) at the top of the
central nerve where the four passages (eye, ear,
nose and tongue) meet, you will see the vast
expanse (of wisdom) above the suture of the
head. Then there can be no talk of the emis-
sary of Death even in dreams.

626 They (Yogies) cultivated the quality of love
(Niyamam), subdued desires (Iyamam), ascended
the spinal column (Pranayamam), and worshipp-
ed (Dhyanam) and mingled with the Lord
(Samadhi), the faith-worthy source (of all Crea-
tion), the Revealer of the Vedas, lustrous as pure
gold.

627 Wondrous forms of lustrous hues appear between
the eye-brows in the region of the moon (Chan-
dramandalam, head) at the junction where the
different airs (led by the Yogi) upwards from
the fundament through triangular and quadran-
gular regions (Atharas) meet in unison.

628 The Yogi should eschew distracting thoughts,
ascend with the abdominal fire and seek the
Supreme Architect, the lustrous Creator of all
the world, contemplating divine communion, and
become (of the form of) God. This is the ex-
alted refreshing state of Samadhi.

To those thus enjoying (Yogic) repose, contem-
plating divine communion, there will be mental
equanimity, the Good Lady (Tirohana Sakti),
that was hitherto veiled will uncover Herself,
shedding Her angry look (become Arul Sakti and
bestow Her Grace) and union with the Truth
(God) will ensue.

Section II of the third Tantarim refers briefly to
the benefit that accrues to the Yogi who practises the
eight-stepped Yogam, அட்டாங்க யோகப்பெறு.
This as already stated when speaking of Samadhi and
the steps preceeding it is union with God. This truth
is formally reiterated in this section, and we are told
that devotees in whatever manner they worship God,
they attain Swargam and the World of God, where
they are welcomed by the Devas and ascetic sages.
Whatever boons they pray for, God grants. They
become (of the Form of) God. They enjoy heavenly
Bliss. They overcome death, while the so-called
Devas not devoted to God are liable to be born in
this world.

Section III speaks of அட்டமாதிரி, literally the
eight great accomplishments, miraculous deeds which
Yogis are capable of performing. These are: 1 அணிமா
or contractive power, becoming smaller even than an
atom, 2 விமா or expanding power, increasing bulki-
ness, becoming larger even than the world, 3 இலகிமா
or infinite lightness, becoming lighter even than tree
cotton fibre, 4 சரிமா or penetrating power, perva-
sion without contamination like Akas (Space), 5 பிராப்தி
or the power of attaining whatever is
desired, 6 பிழாக்காமிமா or power of going anywhere

including migration into and re-vitalising of dead bodies at will, 7 ஈசத்துவம் or lordship exercising dominion over all nature and 8 வசத்துவம் or enchanting power, attracting as if by a spell.

Attachment to one's kindred prolongs bondage. It takes twelve years of devoted practice for one to become an adept in Yoga Sadanai which, as we said before, should be done under the guidance of a competent Guru. Seven years' practice, we are told, confers mental vigour and nimbleness of body enabling the practiser to travel long distances without feeling the strain. Eight years tend to rejuvenate the body, nine years make it handsome and ten years Godlike. The eight kinds of miraculous powers accrue at the end of eleven years, and twelve years practice enables him to go to and pervade the fourteen worlds, seven above and seven below. Over and above all these is the attainment of Gnanam or Godly Knowledge, the final Goal of Yoga-Sadanai. We read: (To be continued)
