Nothing exists without mantras, All beings moving and unmoving have their respective mantras. There are celestial beings whose tatvas are mantra tatvas (சுத்தமாயாதத்துவங்கள்) and whose sariras are Mantra Sariras (血液量多數量质 மேனிகள்).

It is important to know that Mentra Shakti is also divine shakti. When the all pervading nature of Divine Shakti gets localised, it is said to be Mantra Shakti. In fact it is modified Divine Shakti. The modification is caused by the impact of Divine Shakti with the sense of 'I' that lingers even in the case of highly evolved beings who dwell in the Sudha Maya regions of pure consciousness.
