## **CURRICULUM**

### **Catholic students' union**

The members of our Catholic Union were at the forefront in creating a religious atmosphere and in organizing religious events whether it be the observance of First Fridays or celebrating Holy Mass on important days.

A full day spiritual seminar was conducted by Rev. Fr. Rajanayagam for students from grade 06 to grade 13 on the theme of Leadership.

A talk was given by Rev. Sr. Arul on "The Holy Family Association" with a view of increasing vocations to the religious life. Christmas Oli Vizha was celebrated in a spirit of joy and peace. Rev. Fr. A. Jeyasekaram delivered the message on that occasion.

### **Hindu Union**

The Hindu union had its usual activities for the year under the teacher in charge Mrs. D. Nagendran. The students participated in

the religious knowledge examination conducted by the Saiva Paripalana Sabai and obtained good results. They also took part in the contests conducted by the Department and won 13 places at Divisional Level and 3 places at Zonal Level

The annual event of a pilgrimage to Thurkai Amman temple for Sarasvathi Pooja was also successfully organized.

### **Tamil Union**

The Tamil Manram plays an important role in organizing activities for the students to develop their skills and talents by organizing various contests and debates. It also enables them to appreciate our Tamil culture and tradition. Tamil Day contests were conducted at school level and the winners were sent for Inter School Competitions.

Tamil Day was celebrated with the usual enthusiasm with Mrs. Ammankili Murugathas, Cultural Director Northern Province, as Chief Guest and Rev. Fr. F. J. Anthonydas as Guest of Honor. It was an opportunity for the students to display their musical and histrionic talents. The highlight of the day was the classical drama "Aram Kootaheem".

Our students also participated in the Essay and Poetry Contests organized in connection with Elders' Day. Marlin Dharshini Joseph won the first place at Provincial Level and participated at National Level.

### **English Union**

The English Union has played a considerable part in making the English Language come alive for the students by conducting Written and Oral Competitions in connection with English Day, which was held in October 2010.

Our students got a number of places in the English Day contests held by the Department of Education. Our primary action song got second place at Divisional Level. Our junior group and senior group song got second places at district level.

Our senior poetic drama "Othello" and junior drama "Precious Treasure" won 2<sup>nd</sup> places at Divisional Level for the year 2010. Our senior dialogue drama "Thakur's Well" was placed first at Provincial Level for the year 2009.

We must not forget our English Teachers who spent their energy in uplifting the standard of English in our school. Their hard work has reaped excellent results attained in the competitions they participated.

### **Information Technology**

Information Technology which was formerly taught in the G.C.E. (A/L) and (O/L) classes has now been extended to classes down to Gr. 8. The school received six new computers from the Department in 2009 and the former computer room has been renovated.

90% of our students who offered this subject were successful at the G.C.E O/L exam in 2009 and 100% success in the Bilingual medium and 95.6% in the Tamil medium in the year 2010.

Dhakshayini Liguorian from Gr. 8 was placed third in the SEMP software contest at Provincial Level. Mayoore Norbert was placed 7<sup>th</sup> in the IT examination for A/L students conducted by the Jaffna Science Association.

Our school was selected 7<sup>th</sup> in the year 2009/2010 at the "National ICT Excellence

Award” and allocated Rs 300000 for further development of the ICT.

Mrs.E.T. James Michael and Mr. M.M Maxon function as coordinators for all the IT activities of the school.

## **Aesthetics**

The Fine Arts of Music, Dance, Art and Drama provide a great opportunity for students to develop their individual talents.

They are also a means of instilling culture and refinement in our students who are living in a mechanical and prosaic world.

Our students in fine arts have not only done well in their examinations but also have enthusiastically taken part in competitions and won prizes.

In particular a number of our Art students have taken part in contests conducted by various bodies related to special occasions and won certificates and cash prizes.

Our group dance was placed first at Zonal Level at the aesthetic contest organized by the Jaffna Division. Rosin RekaThamilarasan from Gr. 12 came out first and Maureen Judina Mathuranayagam third in the individual events.

Drama and Theatre has been introduced as a subject in Gr. 9 for the first time. Students who appeared for this subject at the A/L Exam obtained 100% passes. They have also won prizes at several competitions.

The model of a stage made by T. Sinthuja was placed first in the aesthetics competition held by the Jaffna Division.

Our home science students participated in the sewing, flower - making and Kolam competitions at Zonal Level. Rathika Ravi and Rebecca Mangalesvaran Gr. 10 won the first and second places in kolam respectively and Judsa Jerome got the 2<sup>nd</sup> place in sewing.

## **Drama and Theatre- 2010**

- Ø The subject Drama and Theatre was introduced and commenced for Grade 9 students.
- Ø The literary drama, ‘Arangootham’ which was staged by the students of Drama and Theatre for the Tamil Day competition of this year won first place at School Level, Zonal Level and District Level and second place at Provincial Level.
- Ø Miss MarlinTharshini Joseph of grade 11 participated in the creation of Drama Script Competition and won the first place at School, Zonal, District and Provincial Levels.
- Ø In the aesthetic competition conducted by Jaffna Educational Zone, the ‘stage model’ created by Miss T. Sinthuja won the first place in Drama and Theatre section.
- Ø The National Institute and Dialogue Television Institution combined and produced CD for Teaching Aid and our school’s Drama and Theatre students of Grade 10 and teachers together produced 4 CD’s and they were appreciated.
- Ø It is remarkable to say that we got 100% (out put) success in the G.C.E(O/L) and G.C.E(A/L).
- Ø Mr.J. Johnson Rajkumar took up the responsibility for Drama & Theatre and through his untiring efforts has brought much credit to our school.

## **Commerce Union**

The Commerce Union has been functioning actively under the guidance of the moderater Mrs. P. Thirugnanasambanthan and the able leadership of its president Thenuga Jeromious and the other office bearers.

The tenth issue of the union's magazine was brought out on 16.11.2010. Mr. R. Kathiraimalai from the Institute of Higher Technology was the Chief Guest on this occasion.

The union also organized a General knowledge contest in the upper classes to increase the students' knowledge in this field. The commerce students who are working with the banks functioning in the school are doing good work. Last year one of our students Tharshika Yogesvaran completed her 6 months internal training at the Bank of Ceylon.

### ***Science and Maths Union***

The Union organized a round of activities to promote interest in science among the students.

An astronomy camp was arranged for Gr.9 students on 13.08.2010. Mr. E. Ratnasingam, the co-ordinator of the Teachers' Resource Centre gave the necessary guidance and demonstration.

A science exhibition was held for students from Gr. 06 to Gr. 11 and the best three exhibits were selected from each section. A science quiz was also held.

Our students participated in the quiz competition conducted by the Dept. of Education. Mary Priyanka from Gr.9 (Tamil medium) and Arulmalar Antony from Gr.11 (Bilingual medium) came third in the Maths quiz at District Level and participated at Provincial Level.

Some students from Gr. 11 and Gr. 13 participated in the chemistry quiz conducted by the Royal Australian Chemistry Institute.

2 students obtained high distinctions and 8 obtained distinctions. The moderator Mrs. J. Jebaratnam, the president Kajani Rajkumar and secretary Mahisniya Perinpanayagam are greatly commended for their enthusiastic work.

### ***Environment Pioneer Group***

This group seeks to create awareness of keeping the environment clean and beautiful. It aims to keep the school premises and surroundings free from pollution by removal of waste and growing useful plants. Membership is voluntary and 25 members are contributing their service under the guidance of their moderator Mrs. Anoja Anton.

Environment day was observed on June 5<sup>th</sup> with shramadana and various competitions.

### ***School Library***

It is true that the idea of modern technology has brought a variety of novelty in many aspects to this millennium. Many educationists agree that the influence of the audio-video equipment does wonders in the class rooms. But unfortunately a large number of people very specially students are not avid for books and do not have good reading habits. Our school library has been classified into three sections.

### ***Reference, Lending, Auditorium***

There are Periodicals, Magazines, Newspapers displayed in the reference section. A large collection of more than 5000 books are available here. In 2009 eighty two new books were included and in 2009 about 198 new books were added while the number of students visiting per day are only 170.

Every year we celebrate "Library week from October 21<sup>st</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup>. Students are encouraged to collect and create assignments about library. We have a system of giving prizes to the students who make the maximum use of the library.

### **Sport sand games**

Our Annual Athletic Meet was held on June 8<sup>th</sup> in the school grounds. Mrs U. Sivapalan, Divisional Director of Education, Jaffna, was the Chief Guest and Rev.Fr.A.Sahayathan, lecturer, British College of English, Thirunelvely, the Guest of Honour.

Our athletes participated at the Zonal and District level sports competition and 10 were selected to compete at Provincial Level and 5 at National Level.

### **Net ball**

Our under 15, under 17 and under 19 teams took part at the Zonal Level and District Level competitions.

### **Basket ball**

Our under 19 basketball team won the first place at Provincial Level and participated at National Level.

Our team was also champions in Dr.Holmes Memorial Basketball Tournament organized by Jaffna College and also won the first place in the Basketball Tournament organized by the Jaffna District Rotary Club.
