Information Communication Technology

Our school had 100% passes at the G.C.E O/L both in the English and Tamil medium. In the Grade 12 General Information Technology exam 103 out of the 106 students who sat secured passes.

IT is taught as a subject from Grade 06 – 11 classes, computers have been set up in the Primary school library to teach the children the basics of the subject. 37 teachers from our school followed courses such as ICDL and IPICT and obtained certificates.

Guidance and Counselling

The need for counselling is felt very keenly among our students, who are affected by war, violence and other factors.

A special Unit has been set up in the school to provide guidance and counselling and to create awareness. A training seminar was conducted for the Prefects to empower them and create self awareness.

A one-day leadership camp was conducted for 55 A/L students by Rev. Fr. Ravichandran. It helped them to discover their strengths and weaknesses and to acquire leadership qualities like self-motivation and team spirit.
