

He was the greatest thinker of the worl before Karl Marx.


The London B. B. C. conducted a survey among People, was to Findout who is the person whose thinking has affected, the greater number of people in the world.

The school came very popular in 20 years all over the world.

Many students from many countries came there and studied at that Acadamey. Astronomy, Biology and Geometry was taught there.

# **OLYMPIC GAMES**

He went to olympic games.

A person who learn music must be of good behaaviour and educational aspects.



### COUNTRY LOST BY WAR


Aristotle went to honey moon

He was weel dressed and with more sports activities.

The Academy was defenaing Aristotle Theories and Policies

Aristotle work was of 232808 lines.

He discovered fertilizer.


He discovered the process of Inhaling oxygen and giving out carbon Di Oxide.
