

The central motif is from the adaptation of the Dutch coats of arms which the Colombo District Scouts Association has adopted as its crest. The colour maroon is the color of passion.


The tree and the bird the roots and the green background depicts environment in all its glory.

### The Real Fun of Collecting Scouts on Stamps

Collecting "Scouts-On-Stamps" the same as any hobby, requires both time and money. How much time? How much money? Just about as much of each as the individual collector decides to give.

Most collectors have more of the first than the last. Should this restrict the fun that he can have with his collection? Not really...in fact, some of the most interesting collectors that we meet are those whose



collections have been made attractive because of their real interest in the hobby.

Occasionally we find a collector whose main purpose in collecting is to possess a "complete" collection. He, poor soul, is a prime target of those who would sell anything and everything even remotely connected with the hobby. This

collector must also, he thinks, mount his collection in the finest (usually most expensive) manner to be certain that his collection is "top." Often the accessory cost exceeds the relative monetary value of his collection. He probably feels that he has real fun with his Scout stamps.

The real fun, however, comes from keeping the collection simple, at least in the beginning or if finances dictate, and interesting. Researching all of the Scouts-On-Stamps issues can be the greatest of fun. Many interesting hours can be spent this way. With as much information as one can find about his collection, it can be followed by producing his own mounting system and album. [This task is made

much easier today with use of a computer and laser printer.] The completeness of data about his collection can have more real value to the collector and his stamp collecting friends than its market value.

The real fun is also found in the many new and wonderful acquaintances that the collector makes by correspondence and in person because of his hobby. Many would say that stamp collecting is an introverted hobby...not so! The real fun collector makes many lasting friendships in philately.



# Welcome to the Camporee 2012

This is the 49th Camporee that the Colombo District has organised. The story started in 1949 when Capt. Vernon Halpe who was then a teacher at Royal Primary school, together with Mr. Aliossen , held the first in this series of events, at the Royal Primary school (now part of Royal College) According to our records this was held from the 5th to the 7th of August 1949. After 48 Camporees, and with much experience, in organising Camporees, the District Commissioner, the Organising Commissioner and the team welcomes every one of you to this grand event. A list of Camporees we've had so far since 1949, would appear elsewhere in this hand book.

To make your life at the Camporee more enjoyable, we are jotting down some information which would be useful.

Law The Scout Law would be the law of the Camporee.

**Arrival** You may arrive at the Vihara Maha Devi Park to your camp site any time from 6.30 a.m. on Thursday the 23rd. Exactly where your camp site is would have been shown to your Scout Leader prior to this. Please do not bring vehicles inside. Please cooperate.

**Camporee office** The Camporee office would be open from 3.00 p.m. on the 23rd. All those Scout Groups who have not been able to collect the Camporee badges should collect them from the office without delay.

**Scout Leaders' meetings** Scout Leaders' meetings would be held every night starting at 8.30 p.m. If all the leaders come on time we could finish the meetings early, and release your Scout Leader back to you.

**Toilets** Special toilets are constructed for the use of the Campers. Please be careful when using them. You will not be the only person using them. In addition to that, there may be park toilets open most of the time ,where you will have to pay a small fee to use them.





Water In addition to the taps near the shower area, we will have water points close to the Sub Camps too. Please do not waste water. We suggest that you have some old news paper, cut to size of about 1Ft X 1Ft, wipe your plate clean before going to the tap to wash the plate. This is to prevent grains of rice, pieces of noodles etc collecting under the tap.

**Lights out** Every day from 11 p.m. would be the light out time. We understand that you would be working until late on the 23rd. But at least on the 24th & 25th &26th we expect you to go to sleep by 11 p.m. If you are unable to sleep, please, at least do not disturb the others. Please try to reduce your late night sing song sessions to a minimum, to prevent disturbing the others who might want to sleep.

**Refreshments, Groceries etc.** There will be refreshments and groceries stalls at the Camporee for you to purchase your requirements.

**Scout Shop** The Scout shop would function from the evening of the 23rd. You could purchase stickers and other Scout material that you require from here

**Skill-O –Rama** The Scout activities will start at 9.00 a.m. on the 25th and the 26th. More details about this is given in a different section of this hand book.

Film Show We are trying to organise a special film show for you on the 24th night

**Camp Fire** We will have Sub Camp fires on the 24th starting at 8.30 p.m. These will be coordinated by the Sub Camp Chiefs. Prepare your environmentally friendly messages for the camp fire.

**Site and Uniform Inspections** These will be held daily starting at 8.00 a.m. these will be coordinated by the Sub Camp Chiefs. Please do make sure that you have your breakfast before the inspections.

**Sub Camp Rallies** These too will be held daily at 8.45 and will be conducted by the Sub Camp Chiefs.

Opening ceremony This is scheduled to start at 4.30 p.m. on Friday the 24th. It is very important that as many Scouts as possible participate in this. You may leave a few Scouts to look after your site. But we do hope that all the rest would come for the opening ceremony. Please do cooperate.

**Closing Ceremony.** This will start at 7.00 p.m. and will end with the TALENT SHOW. Please leave some Scouts to look after your camp site and the rest should come for the closing ceremony and to enjoy the talent show, which would start soon after the closing ceremony.

# The Sub-camps...

Sinharaja Forest Reserve is a national park and a biodiversity hotspot in Sri Lanka. It is of international significance and has been designated a Biosphere Reserve and World Heritage Site by UNESCO.

The hilly virgin rainforest, part of the Sri Lanka lowland rain forests eco region, was saved from the worst of commercial logging by its inaccessibility, and was designated a World Biosphere Reserve in 1978 and a World Heritage Site in 1988. The reserve's name translates as Kingdom of the Lion.

The reserve is only 21 km (13 mi) from east to west, and a maximum of 7 km (4.3 mi) from north to south, but it is a treasure trove of endemic species, including trees, insects, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.

Because of the dense vegetation, wildlife is not as easily seen as at dry-zone national parks such as Yala. There are about 3 elephants and the 15 or so leopards are rarely seen. The commonest larger mammal is the endemic Purple-faced Langur.

An interesting phenomenon is that birds tend to move in mixed feeding flocks. Of Sri Lanka's 26 endemic birds, the 20 rainforest species all occur here, including the elusive Red-faced Malkoha, Green-billed Coucal and Sri Lanka Blue Magpie.

Reptiles include the endemic Green pit viper and Hump-nosed vipers, and there are a large variety of amphibians, especially tree frogs. Invertebrates include the endemic Common Birdwing butterfly and the inevitable leeches.

Kanneliya-Dediyagala-Nakiyadeniya or KDN is a forest complex in southern Sri Lanka. The forest complex designated as a biosphere reserve in 2004 by UNESCO. The KDN complex is the last large remaining rainforest in Sri Lanka other than Sinharaja. This forest area has been identified as one of the floristically richest areas in South Asia. The forest complex is situated 35 km northwest of city of Galle. The rain forest is a major catchment area for two of the most important rivers in southern Sri Lanka, the Gin and Nilwala Rivers. This biosphere reserve harbors many plants and animal species endemic to Sri Lanka.

Knuckles Mountain Range lies in central Sri Lanka, in the Districts of Matale and Kandy. The range takes its name from a series of recumbent folds and peaks in the west of the massif which resembles the knuckles of clenched fist when viewed from certain locations in the Kandy District. Whilst this

name was assigned by early British surveyors, the Sinhalese residents have traditionally referred to the area as Dumbara Kanduvetiya meaning mist-laden mountain range (Cooray, 1984). The entire area is characterised by its striking landscapes often robed in thick layers of cloud but in addition to its aesthetic value the range is of great scientific interest. It is a climatic microcosm of the rest of Sri Lanka. The conditions of all the climatic zones in the country are exhibited in the massif. At higher elevations there is a series of isolated cloud forests, harboring a variety of flora and fauna, some of which cannot be found anywhere else in the world. Although the range constitutes approximately 0.03% of the island's total area it is home to a significantly higher proportion of the country's biodiversity.

Hurulu Forest Reserve of Sri Lanka was designated as a biosphere reserve in January 1977. The forest reserve is an important habitat of the Sri Lankan Elephant. Hurulu forest reserve represents Sri Lanka dry-zone dry evergreen forests. There are many other protected areas situated around Hurulu Forest Reserve viz. Ritigala strict nature reserve, Minneriya-Girithale and Mahaweli flood plains nature reserves, Wasgamuwa National Park and Kahalla-Pallekele sanctuary.

Bundala National Park is an internationally important wintering ground for migratory water birds in Sri Lanka. Bundala harbors 197 species of Birds, the highlight being the Greater Flamingo, which migrate in large flocks. Bundala was designated a wildlife sanctuary in 1969 and redesignated to a national park on 4 January 1993. In 1991 Bundala became the first wetland to be declared as a Ramsar site in Sri Lanka. In 2005 the national park was designated as a biosphere reserve by UNESCO, the fourth biosphere reserve in Sri Lanka. The national park is situated 245 kilometres (152 mi) southeast of Colombo.

The Bar Reef is a system of coral reefs just offshore from Sri Lanka's Kalpitiya peninsula. It has the greatest biodiversity of any coral reef in the waters around India and is one of the few pristine coral reef systems in Sri Lanka.

It is a complex of reefs which stretch parallel to the coast from the northern end of the Kalpitiya peninsula to the islands which separate Portugal Bay from the Gulf of Mannar. It has high ecological, biological and aesthetic significance, being home to 156 species of coral and 283 species of fish.

The Bar Reef was declared a marine sanctuary in 1992, the area of the reserve being 306.7 square km.

ස්වභාවික පරිසරයෙන් බොහෝ තරුණ කොටස් ශීසුයෙන් ඈත් වෙමින් සිටින යුගයක, බාලදකු වාහාපාරය ස්වාභාවික ලොව තුළ රටවැසියන් හා ලෝකය අතර සම්බන්ධතා ඇති කිරීමෙහි ලා විශේෂ මෙහෙයක් කරයි.

සියයට 50 කට අධික පිරිසක් නාගරික වටපිටාවක ජීවත්වන අවධියක පරිසරය පිළිබඳ පුතිරූපය ගස්වැල් වනසතුන් හා ආරකෘණයෙන් ඔබ්බට ගිය විශාල රාජෳයක් ලෙස අන්තර්ගත කිරීම වැදගත් කාරණයකි.

එම නිසා බාලදඎයින්ට ඔවුන්ගේ නාගරීකරණය වූ වටපිටාවේ කිුයාවන් හා ස්වභාවික ලෝකයේ ඇති කිුයාවලිය අතර ඇති සම්බන්ධතාව පෙන්වාදීම පාරිසරික අධාාපනයේ ඇති වැදගත්ම මූලාංගය යි.

බාලදඎයින් මෙවැනි දුෂ්කරතා පිළිබඳව අවබෝධයක් ලබා ගතයුතු අතර, ඔවුන්ගේ පුදේශවල / රටවල පාරසරික ගැටළු සම්බන්ධයෙන් හෝ පරිසරය ආරකෘා කිරීම පිළිබඳව කුමන තීරණ ගතයුතු දැයි යන්න පිළිබඳව තම තමන් දනුවත් වීම ඉතා අවශාය. පරිසරය යනු විශ්ව විෂයයකි. බාලදඎ වාාපාරයද විශ්ව වාාපාරයකි. පරිසරය පිළිබඳව ඉගැන්වීමෙන්, බාලදඎයින්ට විශාල වෙනසක් කළ හැක.
