



TAMIL RELIEF CENTRE

History of TRC:

The Tamil Relief Centre was set up in March 1992 in the name of TAMIL REFUGEE CENTRE to assist Tamil refugees to resettle in this country. In order to empower the newly arrived refugees to achieve their full potential as members of the British society and become fully able to exercise the rights and responsibilities as British Citizens, the TRC embarked on a programme of education and training by creating the Enfield Education & Training Centre. The success of this programme attracted members of other minority ethnic communities and this demand necessitated changes to our aims and objectives. Thus the TAMIL RELIEF CENTRE was newly set up with wider aims and objectives in October 1998. This enabled us to provide services to members of all communities and currently the take up of services from ethnic minority communities other than Tamils in the Education and Training Division is 86% and in the Community Welfare Division is 25%. The Tamil Relief Centre is now a company limited by guarantee with charitable status.

In keeping with this growth and quality of service delivery, TRC has been awarded Quality Mark from Community Legal Service, Investor in People, MATRIX by the Guidance Accreditation Board for information, advice and guidance services and exemption to provide immigration services by the Office of the Immigration Service Commission

The Objectives of TRC: The objectives of the TRC are to relieve the poverty of Tamil and other immigrants and refugees; to advance the education of the public in Tamil culture and to promote the development and advancement of Tamil culture; to provide classes in English Language, Information Technology and employment support; to preserve and protect the mental and physical health and well being of refugees and their dependants and to assist Tamil and other refugees in overcoming cultural and other barriers and to integrate with the local community.

Services provided by the TRC:

To achieve the objectives, the TRC has established two divisions, the Community Welfare Division and the Education and Training Division under which a number of projects operate. TRC currently employ 4 full time and 21 part-time staff with a total turnover of £373,107.48 for the year 2006/2007

Airconditioned Fully Licenced Veg & Non-Veg Eat-in & Take-away **Advice and Information:** The services provided by this project include advice, information advocacy and one to one support to access services that are provided by statutory, voluntary, and independent sector organisations in a wide variety of social welfare areas such as immigration, nationality, welfare benefits, housing, health, children and adult education and training and employment. The project works closely with statutory and non-statutory organisations.

Women's Integration Project: This project addresses the particular needs of refugee women who are housebound either because of language and cultural barriers or who suffer domestic violence and lack self-confidence in dealing with issues affecting their daily life. This project seeks to address isolation in their own homes by providing counselling, advocacy and support and skills training to women in order to enable them to access services, follow ESOL classes, increase self confidence and independence, and enter further education, training or employment.

Elders' Project: This project helps elders to overcome isolation and emotional problems and to promote active and healthy life style by providing them the facilities to meet together and talk to people from their own community in their own language, to obtain information and to forge fellowship thus enabling them to lead a fulfilling life. These are done by organising Talks; Keep fit classes, Yoga, Health Clinics, Drop-ins, Luncheon meetings, leisure trips and a Day Centre.

EDUCATION AND TRAINING DIVISION:

Currently we run courses towards an OCR qualification in Skills for Life, at Entry III level in reading, writing, listening and speaking skills, courses in Information Technology towards City and Guilds NVQ or ECDL Certificate, advice, guidance and information on careers, Personal Development and other related issues, and a course towards a certificate that can help with the British Citizenship test. Booster Classes in English, Maths and Science for pupils in year 4 to year 11 by professional School Teachers based on the National Curriculum and computer classes for children are conducted on Saturdays and Sundays. We also offer crèche places for children between 2 _ to 5 years old.

This event is about celebrating our achievement of Education at EETC which means to celebrate the good work we children have done.

We have three subjects, first we have English after Science and then Maths. I enjoy all the lessons.

When I came to England, my English was poor but now I have improved very much in my English because of attending these support classes. English is my third language. Now I don't find it hard. I have also improved in my spelling through these support classes running by TRC. English teacher tries to get our attention. She tries to keep us good. She is a very good teacher.

We also enjoy Science. It is my favorite subject. I have improved at school and have got good scores in tests. Science teacher is a very good and nice teacher.

In maths I have improved my time tables and I am faster in adding, subtracting, dividing etc. Maths teacher is quick in maths. He is friendly and nice.

In overall, I gained a lot of improvement by attending these support classes.
