## A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE INSTITUTE OF WESTERN MUSIC & SPEECH [I.W.M.S]

The Institute of western Music and Speech was founded in 1960, when it was known as the "Association of Teachers Of Western Music and Dramatic Art". It was the combined effort of qualified and experienced teachers of Music, Speech and Drama, who dedicated themselves solely towards achieving a common objective – that of promoting, nurturing and developing the talents of the children of our country in the field of Western Music, Speech and allied subjects.

Today the institute {I.W.M.S} is a fully fledged, state recognized Institute, incorporated in 1998, by the act of parliament No. 44 without share capital or other commercial attribute. It has grown in stature, and has established a reputation as a largest, most progressive and innovative, local Examining Board in Sri Lanka, and allied subjects in all grades including Diplomas. The syllabus compiled by qualified and experienced examiners, are in keeping with internationally accepted standards. The institute met the challenge way back in 1971, when the conduct of foreign examinations was discontinued. The introduction of Written English Examinations and Speech Theory in 1984, was another step towards the expansion in the scope of examinations. The syllabuses in speech subjects, Spoken English and Written work offer the best of both traditional and contemporary thinking on the value of the spoken and Written word in modern life and the best ways to examine the work presented. Another challenge was met in 1999, when the request of numerous teachers, the I.W.M.S. introduced the senior certificate in Theory Music.



This will be beneficial to candidates offering Music as a subject at the G.C.E.(Ordinary Level) Examination. As a help to Teachers ,I.W.M.S introduced in 1998 the Certificate of Proficiency for the Teaching of English ,Levels I and II in Practical and Theory. We hope to Introduce similar examinations in 2003 for the benefit of Music Teachers too.

In addition to this, in keeping with the objectives of the Institute, several other programmes in the form of concerts and Competitions have been organized throughout the years with a view to encouraging young talent.

The Institute has always catered to the needs of the teachers of Music, speech and allied subjects, by way of organizing seminars, workshops and programmes which have paved the way for closer co-operation, understanding and cordiality between the teachers of Music and Speech and the Examiners of the Institute.

A long felt need was realized in 1993 when the Institute moved into its own premises at No.12, Kotalawela Gardens, Colombo-4 Currently the office is managed by an efficient staff, whilst the Members render their honorary services to the Institute.

The Institute of Western Music and Speech is a firmly rooted body, comprising of a membership of professionally qualified teachers In Music and speech who contribute immensely towards the smooth functioning of the Institute and the conduct of its examinations. Its funds and property are vested in the Institute and are devoted solely to the advancement of the Arts- Music, Speech and allied subjects as set in its Constitution.

## THE HISTORY OF ROYAL ENGLISH ACADEMY

*This academy was started in 1997 to facilitate the students who were interested to learn English. Since there wasn't any organization to promote the standard of English among the students of Sammanthurai, the idea of opening this type of academy came into my mind.*

*We started only with a few students in 1997. The number of students has been increasing gradually during the past six years. And we have now 500 students from nursery to G.C.E (O/L). In 1997 there was only one teacher but now there are 20 teachers specialized in various fields.*

# REPORT OF THE ELOCUTION UNIT

## FROM 2000 TO 2003

---

The Elocution unit of Royal English Academy, Sammanthurai happily Welcomes the chief guest, Guest of honour; other distinguished guests, parents, well-wishers, and students.

The future of our nation is in the hands of the younger generation. The international language, English is the key to help them to achieve their efforts.

The Director of the Royal English Academy, Mr.A.A.Nazeer realized this and tried his best and encouraged the parents of this area to send their children to the Elocution Classes.

At first some of them were a bit reluctant but eventually when they observed the other children reciting the poems and talking in English they too wanted to enroll their kids.

We are proud to say that we sent students to the Elocution Exams conducted by the I.W.M.S.<sup>Yo</sup> from 2001 onwards. We started this elocution unit in 2000 November. At the beginning we had a number of 65 students and only 42 applied for the exam in 2001. We sent students only to the preliminary grade.

And the following year the number had increased to 80. It gave us encouragement and the parents wanted to send their children to these classes as they shone in their respective schools and even they were selected for the English day competitions.

This year we have 148 students in our unit.50 of them applied for preliminary grade, 32 for initial grade, 39 for elementary grade and 27 for grade one.
